HOLY MASS AT THE BIRTHPLACE OF ST JOHN RIGBY, HARROCK HALL This will be celebrated at 7:00pm, Friday 21st June 2024 at Harrock Hall, WN6 9QD, with principal celebrant, Bishop Tom Neylon. Saint John Rigby, born at Harrock Hall was martyred for being reconciled to the Catholic Church, dying at Southwark on 21st June 1600. It is wonderful to be able to celebrate Holy Mass in honour of St John Rigby at Harrock Hall. All Welcome.



This window on the north (left) side of church was blessed on 15th June 1930 to mark the Beatification of John Rigby, and was a gift of members of

the Rigby family. St John Rigby is also venerated on 25th October as one of the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales. The Roman Martyrology reads: "In London, England, St John Rigby, Martyr, who, arrested and sentenced to death under Queen Elizabeth I for reconciling with the Catholic Church, was hanged in Southwark and disembowelled while still alive."
