Regulations

So that our cemetery is a safe, dignified and respectful place, Our Lady and All Saints has regulations outlined below, and in the attached document:

- Only qualified Memorial Masons, who are registered with NAMM or BRAMM are authorised to work in our cemetery, and all memorial work should conform to the NAMM Code of Working Practice and British Standard BS 8415 current at the time of fixing.
- If a memorial is to be re-installed, all components must also comply with the current standards.
- In order to have any memorial work undertaken, an application must be made by the Memorial Mason to Our Lady and All Saints. No work can be carried out until the application is approved.
- Any memorial erected on a grave is the responsibility of the grave owner.

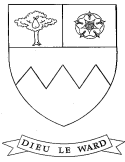
