

**NEW PARISH WEBSITE** The new website is now live and has the same address as the old one. The new site is very interactive, with opportunities on every section to 'Get in Touch' with the right person for your query via the parish office.

In addition to information about Holy Mass times, the process for accessing the sacraments and the Weekly Newsletter, you will also find a section on Parish Life, detailing parish teams and opportunities, a What's On page which includes links to Archdiocesan events and online application forms for Confirmation and Lourdes Youth pilgrimage, our current Ministry Rotas, and our Family of Parishes, established by Synod 2020. Other sections contain interesting information about our grounds, buildings, the history of our parish and school, and past and present clergy.

There are countless fantastic photographs of our church and grounds in circulation, and many have been included in the various sections of the website, adding plenty of colour and interest. Thanks goes to those who have sent in photos, but especially to Paul Jackson, who has submitted a superb selection of photos taken over the last couple of years. Have a look at the stunning pictures of the stained glass windows – a product of Paul's perseverance ensuring these were taken in the best light possible and producing pictures of exceptional quality.

The section on Mass Intentions, details how to submit requests and Mass offerings online, including requests for a person to be added to the Sick List; and the Support Us page gives information about our Financial Status, how you can give financially to the parish, and examples of how your donations are spent. You can also download a Gift Aid form.

Have a look and send in some feedback via a 'Get in Touch' button. This has been a lengthy project, and we would like it to be accurate, fully representative of the parish and explain how things work! Let us know if there is anything that needs to be added or amended, or doesn't work? The site works on desktop, tablet and mobile. However, if you are exploring the site for the first time, then desktop or tablet show it at its best!
