CHRISM MASS This is at 7:30pm on Wednesday 16th April at the Metropolitan Cathedral. This is usually the largest annual gathering of archdiocesan clergy and faithful throughout the year. At the Mass, Archbishop Malcolm blesses the holy oils that are used throughout the archdiocese for celebrations of the sacraments in the next year. He does this in the presence of priests, deacons and lay faithful. In addition, the Archbishop invites the priests of the archdiocese to renew the promises they made at their ordination: to dedicate their life in service to the Church, to preach the Gospel and teach the Catholic faith, to faithfully celebrate the sacraments and to pray for God's people. All welcome and encouraged to attend this liturgy.

The charity Right to Life UK has a simple online mechanism to allow people to contact their Member of Parliament and it only takes a few moments to submit a message to ask an MP to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law. 
