



ARCHBISHOP-ELECT OF LIVERPOOL Bishop John Sherrington was born in Leicester in 1958. Before entering the seminary, he graduated with a BA in mathematics from Queens' College, Cambridge. Upon graduation, he worked for a short period in management consultancy and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Nottingham in 1987.

Bishop Sherrington was ordained

as an Auxiliary Bishop of Westminster in September 2011. Within the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, he is a member of the Department for Social Justice with responsibility for Life Issues since 2014, and a member of the Education Department since 2022. He was appointed the tenth Archbishop of Liverpool by Pope Francis on 5 April 2025. His Installation will take place in the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King on Tuesday, 27 May at 12 noon.
