SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

This solemnity honours the principal foundational figures of the early church. Peter, the first pope and rock upon which Christ built His church, represents unity and leadership, while Paul, the great missionary, "called to be an apostle set apart for the gospel of God" (Romans 1:1) and Apostle to the Gentiles, symbolises evangelisation and doctrine.

Both were martyred separately in Rome, during the reign of Emperor Nero and buried beneath the basilicas bearing their names.

Their commemoration being observed as a holyday, underscores and pays tribute to their importance in the growth and establishment of the Christian faith.
