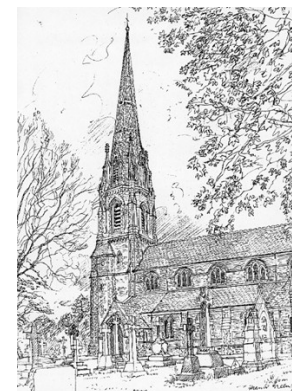

ST JOHN PLESSINGTON (GARSTANG) PRIEST AND MARTYR

Born at Dimples Hall in Garstang,
in 1637, John Plessington was
educated by Jesuits at Scarisbrick
Hall, then at Valladolid and
Saint-Omer. After ordination, he
returned in 1663 to minister in se-
cret around Holywell and Chesh-
ire, using the name of Scarisbrick.

He was arrested in Chester during
the 'Popish Plot' hysteria created
by Titus Oates and in 1679, was
hanged, drawn and quartered at
Broughton in Cheshire for being a
Catholic priest.
