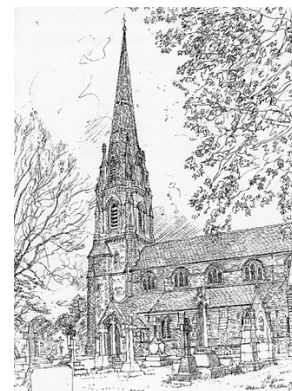

BLESSED JOHN WOODCOCK BLESSED EDWARD BAMBER AND BLESSED THOMAS WHITAKER

These three Lancashire priests
were executed together after
imprisonment at Lancaster
Castle. In their troubled times,
they trained abroad and bravely
returned to the English Mission.

John was a Franciscan, born at
Woodcock Hall, who was also
known by his religious name
Martin of St Felix or his
pseudonym of Farington.

Edward, from Poulton-le-Fylde,
was a chaplain at Standish Hall.
Thomas came from Burnley and
was tortured after being
captured at Goosnargh, suffering
solitary confinement before his
martyrdom.
