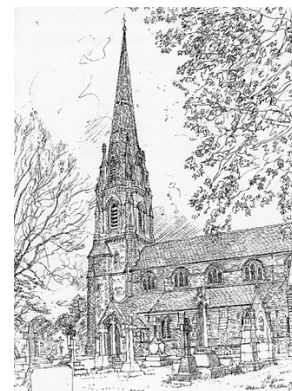

SAINT STEPHEN OF HUNGARY

Born in Hungary around 969, he
was crowned king of Hungary in
1000. He was a just, peaceful and
religious king, keeping strictly to
the laws of the church and always
seeking the good of his subjects.

He established many dioceses and
did much to strengthen the life of
the church. He died in 1038, in
Szekesfehervar.

SAINT CLARE

Born at Assisi in 1193, she followed
her fellow countryman, St Francis
in his life of poverty. She was
founder and ruler of the Poor
Clares, an order of nuns. She led a
very austere life, abounding in
works of piety and charity.
