

Born in Hungary around 969, he was crowned king of Hungary in 1000. He was a just, peaceful and religious king, keeping strictly to the laws of the church and always seeking the good of his subjects.

He established many dioceses and did much to strengthen the life of the church. He died in 1038, in Szekesfehervar.
