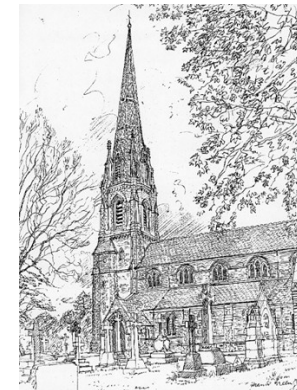

ST EDMUND ARROWSMITH

Born at Haydock to a devout
Catholic family frequently harassed
for their faith. After studies in
Douai, he was ordained in 1612
and ministered in Lancashire
before he was arrested.

King James I's amnesty for Catholic
priests enabled him to join the
Jesuits in 1624 but he was
denounced again and convicted in
1628. He received final absolution
in Lancaster Castle from St John
Southworth. Both were among the
40 Martyrs canonised by Pope Paul
VI.
