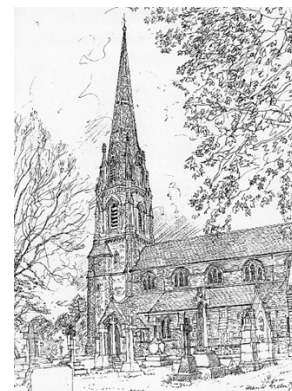

Blessed Carlo, who died in 2006,
aged 15, is due to be canonised next
Sunday, 7th September and will
be the first millennial saint to be
so. He will be canonised alongside
Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati.

SAINT GREGORY THE GREAT

Born in 540 in Rome, he entered a
monastery, was ordained deacon
and undertook the office of a papal
legate to Constantinople. In 590, he
became Pope and was a true pastor
in his administration, care of the
poor and in spreading the faith,
which included sending the monk
Augustine to Britain, to evangelise
the English. He wrote many works
on faith and morals.
