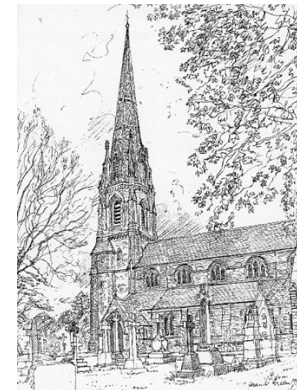

Today, Sunday 7th September,  
Pope Leo XIV will declare London-  
born Carlo Acutis the Catholic  
Church's first Millennial saint.

Acutis, a computer prodigy who  
died in 2006 at the age of 15, is a  
real saint for our times. His  
commitment to the fundamental  
truths of Catholicism, particularly  
his deep devotion to the real  
presence of Christ in the Eucharist,  
are an inspiration to this and  
future generations.

Bishop Hudson is in Rome to  
celebrate the Canonisation and has  
written a personal reflection on  
Carlo Acutis explaining his close  
ties with the Catholic Church in
