

CARLO ACUTIS: FIRST CLASS RELIC AND EXHIBITION OF EUCHARISTIC MIRACLES

Carlo Acutis (1991-2006) had a great devotion to the Eucharist. Using his knowledge of computers, he created a website documenting Eucharistic miracles.

We are privileged to be able to host a **First Class Relic** of Saint Carlo, in **our Church** for nine days.

At the same time, we will be holding an exhibition of 30, of the 160 Eucharistic miracles he curated, each displayed as a poster panel and each accompanied with historical details and scientific analysis. The **exhibition** will be located in **Our Lady and All Saints school**.

Both events will run from **Saturday 14th to Sunday 22nd February**, with opening times in church and school as follows:

Saturdays and Sundays:

11:30am-3:00pm;

Monday to Friday:

11:30am-3:00pm **and** 5:00pm-7:00pm.

Parishioners, friends and relatives are encouraged to visit both the relics and exhibition and to pray and reflect on the reality of this truth.

HEATING IN CHURCH

Since early January, despite the central heating in church being set at the maximum temperature and programmed to come on three hours before each Mass, the general temperature can still feel too cool. By reducing the draughts, we hope to create a warmer, more energy-efficient church environment.

BOUNDARY WALL

You may have noticed work taking place on the boundary wall. This is because a tree had reseeded itself some time ago, via a crack in the mortar. It has been growing along the base of the wall, concealed in the masonry, causing it to lean and fracture. This section of wall has been taken down, the vegetation removed by the grounds team and the wall carefully reconstructed. You'll be amazed at the size of the root!
