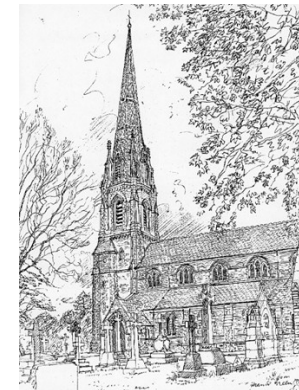

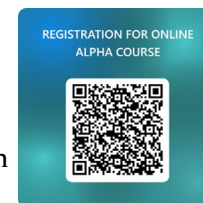
### ADULT FAITH FORMATION BIBLE STUDY: THE CHOSEN
