

DOUGLAS VALLEY OUTREACH

On Monday 15th December there was a Christmas meal offered at the ASK Club Drop-in centre (Ecumenical Centre, Skelmersdale) for asylum seekers and refugees. There were fifty-five attendees over the course of the afternoon, including 2 staff and 6 volunteers. We all had a wonderful meal prepared by some of the Syrian ladies. Fifty toiletry and gift bags were also distributed.

The children from Our Lady and All Saints school donated over forty Christmas gift boxes for asylum seeker and refugee children locally. These were distributed through parties or by home delivery in Skelmersdale, Wigan and Leigh.

Thank you for your continued support enabling a little Christmas spirit to be shared.

FAMILY AID PACKS

The packs are a useful aid for young Catholic singles to understand the dating phase of life better and the issues affecting dating and relationships.

The content is best meditated on in a spirit of prayer, if possible in front of the Blessed Sacrament. The pack is also useful for parents or chaplains to contemplate and take the ideas within the pack to guide or discuss with their teens or youth groups.

The aid encourages the setting up of personal boundaries in a world where anything goes and includes the effects on the human brain of certain behaviours. Thus the Aids can be used by parents as a corrective where the behaviour embarked does not accord with a healthy lifestyle or to open a conversation again.

Parents have the responsibility to assist God in winning their children back to the faith. This comes through knowledge, reason and love shown in care. Thus, the Aid pack can be used as near preparation for marriage or as immediate preparation and a corrective.
