

## CARLO ACUTIS: FIRST CLASS RELIC AND EXHIBITION OF EUCHARISTIC MIRACLES

Carlo Acutis (1991-2006) had a great devotion to the Eucharist. Using his knowledge of computers, he created a website documenting Eucharistic miracles, thereby bringing the truth of the mystery of Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist to the forefront of people's understanding.

We are privileged to be able to host a First Class Relic of Saint Carlo, in **our Church** for nine days.

At the same time, we will be holding an exhibition of 30, of the 160 Eucharistic miracles he curated, each displayed as a poster panel and each accompanied with historical details and scientific analysis.

The headteacher has generously offered **Our Lady and All Saints school hall** to locate the exhibition.

Both events will run from **Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February**, with opening times in church and school as follows:

**Saturdays and Sundays:** 11:30am-3:00pm; **Monday to Friday:** 11:30am-3:00pm and 5:00pm-7:00pm.

## FAMILY AID PACKS

A useful aid for young Catholic singles to understand the dating phase of life better and the issues affecting dating/relationships. The content is best meditated on in a spirit of prayer, if possible in front of the Blessed Sacrament. It is also useful for parents or chaplains to contemplate and take the ideas within the pack to guide or discuss with their teens or youth groups.

The Aid encourages the setting up of personal boundaries in a world where anything goes and includes the effects on the human brain of certain behaviours.

Parents have the responsibility to assist God in winning their children back to the faith. This comes through knowledge, reason and love shown in care. Thus the Aids can be used by parents as a corrective where the behaviour embarked does not accord with a healthy lifestyle or to open a conversation again.
