

confessed the Lord's bountiful
mercy. His book, 'The Confessions of
St Augustine' became a spiritual
classic.

Sr Margaret, an Augustinian nun at
Boarbank Hall, Cumbria says it is, 'a
book-length prayer with
autobiographical passages but all
interwoven with theological
reflections, philosophical meditations
and quotations from scripture.
Sometimes people will find it easier
if they feel they have permission to
dip and skip – slowing down for the
passages which they find easier. Or
just to take a short bit and ponder it
prayerfully.'
