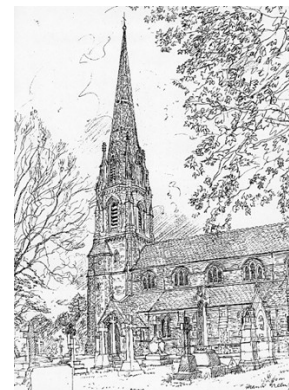

EASTER DUTIES

Many Catholics rightly receive the Lord in
Holy Communion frequently, indeed every
time they attend Mass; but some hold back
because of an exaggerated sense of un-
worthiness.

This is one reason why the Church,
our Holy Mother, insists: 'Once ad-
mitted to the blessed Eucharist, each
of the
Faithful is obliged to receive Holy
Communion at least once a
year. This precept must be fulfilled
during Easter time, unless for a good
reason it is
fulfilled at another time of the
year.' (Canon 920)

Of course, 'Anyone who is conscious
of grave sin may notreceive the
Body of the Lord without previously
having been to sacramental
confession.' (Canon 916)
