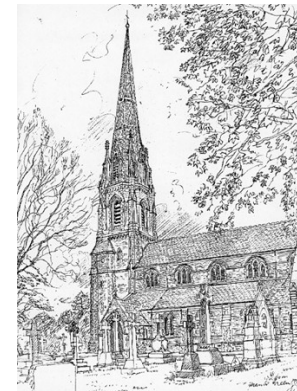

NOVENA OF HOLY HOURS AND CONSECRATION OF THE DEANERY TO THE SACRED HEART

Next Wednesday, 3rd June at 7.00pm
we begin a Deanery Novena of Holy
Hours in preparation for the
consecration of the deanery to the
Sacred Heart on Friday, 12th June.

When we consecrate a thing, we give it
to God. In consecrating the deanery to
the Sacred Heart, we offer it to Him,
asking Him to use us, our families,
homes and our parishes for His glory
and for the good of souls.

There will be a Holy Hour each day
during the Novena (details on the
poster at the back of church and in the
porch), which will culminate in the
consecration of the deanery by Bishop
Neylon during Mass at Our Lady and
All Saints at **7.00pm on Friday 12th
June**, the Feast of the Sacred Heart.

At the end of this Mass, you will receive
a small image of the Sacred Heart,
blessed by the bishop, for you to put up
in your home.
