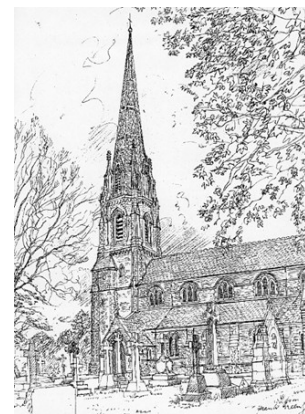

SAINT HENRY

Born in Bavaria, he succeeded his
father as Duke of Bavaria and later
was elected Holy Roman Emperor.

He was outstanding for his reforms
in the Church and for his
encouragement of missionary
activity, setting up many dioceses
and founding monasteries. He was
canonized by Pope Eugene III in
1146.

SAINT BONAVENTURE

Born Giovanni di Fidanza, at
Bagnoregio in Tuscany in 1220, he
studied philosophy and theology in
Paris, receiving a master's degree
and then taught the students of the
Franciscan Order.

He became Minister General of the
Franciscans and ruled the order
with great wisdom and prudence,
later becoming Cardinal Bishop of
Albano. He wrote many influential
works in philosophy and theology,
earning him the title of 'the
Seraphic Doctor'.
