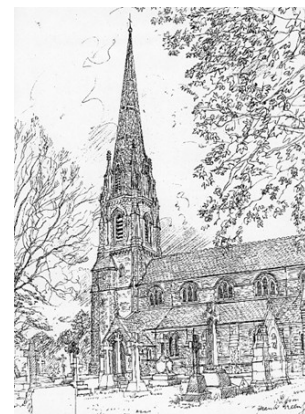

SAINT MARY MAGDALENE

The Church in the East and in the
West has always regarded Saint
Mary Magdalene as the first witness
to Our Lord's resurrection and with
the greatest reverence, has always
honoured her.

A faithful disciple of Christ, Mary
ministered to his needs after having
seven devils cast out of her. She
witnessed his crucifixion, was
present at his burial, as well as
being the first to see the risen Lord.
She was commissioned by Christ to
proclaim the good news of His
resurrection to the apostles.

Mary Magdalene was called 'a
Witness of Divine Mercy' by Saint
Gregory the Great and an 'Apostle
of the Apostles' by Saint Thomas
Aquinas.

SAINT JAMES

Born the son of Zebedee and Salome
in Bethsaida and a fisherman like his
brother John, James (the Greater)
was present with Jesus at the
Transfiguration and in Gethsemane
and witnessed his more important
miracles.

He was killed by King Herod, about
the year 44—the first of the apostles
to be martyred for Christ - and is
venerated especially at Compostela
in Spain, to where tradition holds
that his bones were transported and
which has been since the Early
Middle Ages, a magnificent pilgrim
shrine dedicated to his honour.
