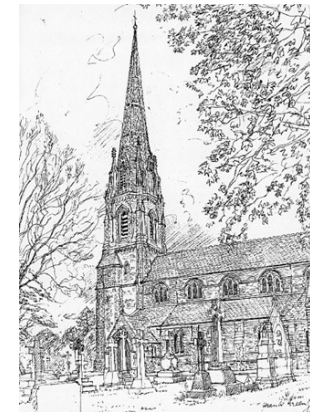

Anyone can ask a priest to offer a Mass, for a variety of reasons e.g. thanksgiving, anniversary, a sick person, the intentions of a particular person, or as is most common, the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

By submitting the online request or filling out an envelope, you consent to your intention being listed on the parish newsletter. If you do not wish the details to appear on the newsletter, please write "Private Intention" in the Mass intention section.
