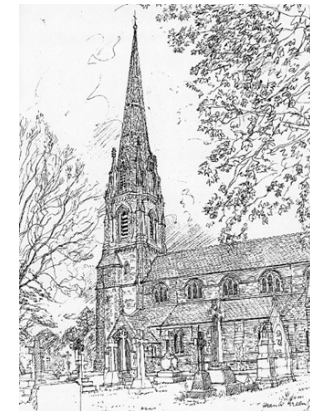

CONTACT YOUR MP TO OPPOSE ASSISTED SUICIDE

The Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill is back in the House of Commons and seeks to legalise assisted dying. It will have its Second Reading and vote on **Friday 11th September** 2026.

Please write to your MP to make your voice heard and oppose the Bill.

Please speak up and voice your opposition. The charity Right to Life UK has a simple online mechanism to do this. It takes little more than a few minutes to enter your postcode, make sure the suggested text suits your viewpoint and submit your message to ask your MP to stop this flawed Bill progressing through parliament. SAINT MAXIMILLIAN KOLBE, PRIEST AND MARTYR

Born in Poland in 1894 as Raymond Kolbe, friar Maximillian had joined the Conventual Franciscans, along with his brother, Francis, in 1907.

Ordained in 1918, after earning a doctorate at Rome, he taught at Krakow Seminary, where he founded several organisations and publications devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

In 1941, his monastery was shut down by the German authorities and he was arrested. He was martyred by lethal injection after volunteering to die in place of another prisoner.

He was cremated on the feast of the Assumption.
